

REVENUE PROCEDURE STATEMENT 87-9

If you are a **professor**, **teacher or researcher with a J-1 or H-1 visa**, **doing teaching or research**, **or receiving compensation** and are a resident of a tax treaty country listed below, <u>you can claim exemption from withholding of tax by completing a form 8233</u> and the statement below.

- 1. I was a resident of the country checked above on the date of my arrival in the United States. I am not a United States citizen. I have not been lawfully accorded the privilege if residing permanently in the United States as an immigrant.
- 2. I am visiting or accepting an invitation for the purpose of **teaching**, or **engaging in research** at the Pennsylvania State University which is a recognized educational, scientific medical facility primarily funded from government sources, I will receive compensation for my teaching, lecturing, or research.
- 3. I arrived in the United States on the date indicated above. The treaty exemption is available only for the time period specified in the appropriate Article of the tax treaty. This exemption begins with the tax year that includes my arrival date.
- 4. If from The Netherlands or Luxembourg, I understand that if my visit to the United States exceeds 2 years, the exemption is lost for the entire visit unless the competent authorities of these countries agree otherwise. If from India or the United Kingdom, the entire treaty exemption is lost retroactively if my stay in the United States exceeds 2 years.
